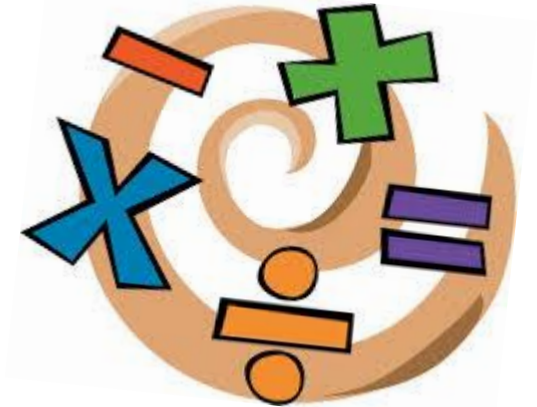

**A:** "I have 319 kids, the whole of school #8."







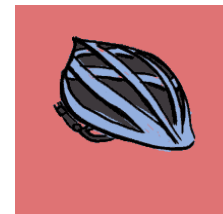
- Remember to always put on sunscreen.

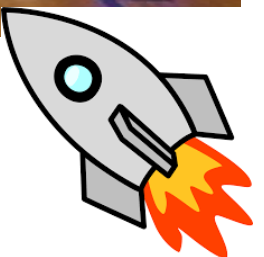
